The EHS policy and management system is shaped by the certified internal Occupational Health, Safety and Environment service of Siemens Nederland N.V. The integrated quality and OHSE management system is certified in accordance with Quality Management (ISO9001), Occupational, Health and Safety Management (VCA (**/P/BTR), OHSAS 18001 and FPAL) and Environmental Management (ISO14001).

Objectives are set annually in the field of Environmental Protection, Health Management and Safety (EHS) by the Managing Board together with the EHS organization. Our objectives are aimed at optimizing our EHS management system and the ongoing improvement of our EHS performance. The objectives are established in consultation with employee representatives in the form of the Works Council. The objectives are monitored by means of the EHS Dashboard. At the end of the year performance is evaluated during the Management Review before new objectives are established for the ensuing period.


